**ON-CALL PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY SERVICES AT
PITTSBURGH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AND ALLEGHENY COUNTY AIRPORT**

The Allegheny County Airport Authority is seeking a consulting firm to provide on-call airport planning and environmental study services at Pittsburgh International and Allegheny County Airports. Typical projects can include, but are not limited to, airport master plan revisions, airport layout plan updates, property map updates, requests for modifications of standards, requests for land releases and safety area studies. Additional typical projects can involve both airport and non-airport development and can include site selections studies, site feasibility studies, site layout plans, utility and infrastructure plans, cost benefit analyses, environmental assessments, categorical exclusions, environmental audits for hazardous materials, archaeological investigations, criteria of effect reports, historic building recordations, and programmatic agreements for historic resources.

Shortlisting for selection will be based on the following evaluation criteria:

- 1) Project staff qualifications and experience on projects of similar nature and scope.
- 2) Project staff knowledge of and experience with FAA and PADOT standards and requirements.
- 3) Ability to provide timely on-call services.
- 4) Ability to meet or exceed Allegheny County Airport Authority goal of a minimum of 14% participation by DBE's certified by the Pennsylvania Unified Certification Program.
