Final Supplemental Environmental Assessment and
Finding of No Significant Impact
for the
PV Solar Array Microgrid Phase 2 Expansion Project
At Pittsburgh International Airport

Interested parties are hereby notified that the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has approved a Final Supplemental Environmental Assessment (Final EA) and prepared a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the proposed PV Solar Array Microgrid Phase 2 Expansion Project at Pittsburgh International Airport (PIT).

The proposed project is the second phase to an existing 3 megawatt (MW) PV solar array, owned and operated by IMG Energy Solutions (IMG), and is located on Airport property in Findlay Township, immediately east of Harper Road and north of the Airport Expressway (Interstate 376). The Phase 2 PV Solar Array will cover approximately 11.6 acres, generate 4.7 MW of power, and be net metered to provide additional power redundancy and resiliency, while also contributing to better sustainability efforts at PIT.

The Final EA and FONSI found that the project is consistent with FAA Order 1050.1F, Environmental Impacts: Policies and Procedures, and with existing national environmental policies and objectives set forth in Section 101 of NEPA, 42 U.S.C. § 4321 et seq., Council on Environmental Quality regulations, 40 C.F.R. Parts 1500-1508, the requirements of Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, and all other applicable special purpose laws. The Proposed Action will not significantly affect the quality of the human environment or otherwise include any condition requiring consultation pursuant to Section 102(2)(C) of NEPA.
