This live-fire training satisfies the requirements as specified in FAA Part 139. Students will receive classroom training on current Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting topics and live fire exercises. The course also includes training and practice on extinguishing live fire in the Large Area Spill Trainer utilizing both handlines and ARFF vehicle turrets. The course also includes a combination of training and live fire scenarios with exterior handlines on the Specialized Aircraft Fire Trainer extinguishing wheels, brakes, and engines. The training package also includes instruction and scenario-based evolutions on interior cabin, cockpit fires and victim rescues.
